Hold Harmless and Indemnification Agreement

I / We, _____, hereby understand and agree to accept the risk of my / our participation in any and all activities for which specific space has been reserved for specific times. This shall include, but not be limited to, assignment of time and space regularly scheduled activities, sporadic use and one time events. With this understanding, I / We further agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Century Arts Alliance Foundation its president and board of directors, agents and employees from and against any all claims, losses, injuries, suits or judgments arising from, or in connection with my / our successors, assign, heirs, executors and administration, and any other person or entities who / which may have a claim based on my / our personal injuries and / or property damage. I / We further understand and agree that this hold harmless and indemnification shall apply to any and all facilities of the Century Arts Alliance Foundation Should any dispute arise which we are unable to resolve through negotiation or the use of third party mediation, the undersigned agree to submit to resolution by arbitration in accordance with the rules of the American Arbitration Association. IN AGREEING TO ARBITRATION, WE BOTH ACKNOWLEDGE THAT IN THE EVENT OF A DISPUTE OVER FEES, EACH OF US IS GIVING UP THE RIGHT TO HAVE THE DISPUTE DECIDED IN A COURT OF LAW BEFORE ANY JUDGE OR JURY AND INSTEAD ARE ACCEPTATIONS THE USE OF ARBITRATION FOR RESOLUTION. The prevailing party shall be entitled to the allowance of a reasonable attorney's fee and other costs of such action.
